The competition is open to students in Years 4, 5 & 6 in all primary schools in Bristol.

To enter the competition, we want you to pair up with a friend and create a two-course menu together, which you think demonstrates the true **"Taste of Summer"**.

Your menu can EITHER be a starter and main course, OR a main course and pudding. You must be able to cook it from start to finish in one hour on a budget of £10. We're looking for menus which use ingredients that are in season in England in July, that are well balanced, look attractive and make us hungry.

Send in your menus by 16th June and our expert panel will judge the most seasonal, exciting, innovative, balanced and appealing. If your menu is selected, we will invite you to come to the competition and cook your menu at the Cookery School on Saturday 3rd July. (Timings to be confirmed)

You will have one hour to produce your dishes, Masterchef-style for our judges to taste and assess.

The winners will receive a place on an Introduction workshop at the Cookery School at Bordeaux Quay, a £200 equipment voucher for their school and the chance to demonstrate their menu in front of an audience at the Bristol Wine and Food Fair's Chefs Theatre on Sunday 4th July.

Second and third places will receive a £50/£25 voucher for Kitchens Cookshop in Clifton, to spend on cookery equipment for your school.
